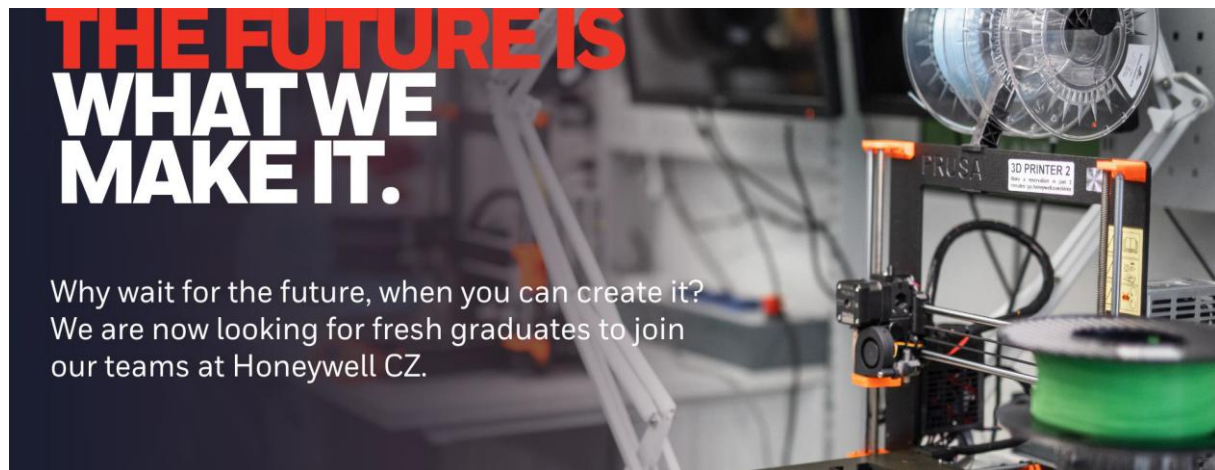




Software Developer - C, C++ - Aerospace
