

### **ABOUT CYBERWATCH**

The U.S. based National CyberWatch Center was established in 2005 at Prince George's Community College in Largo, Maryland to serve as the National Science Foundation's Advanced Technological Education resource center for cybersecurity education and workforce development. In response to growing international interest, the CyberWatch Center was restructured into two organizations. Program development and dissemination in the United States was formed into the National CyberWatch Resource Center. Regional chapter organizations for faculty, students, and practitioners was formed into CyberWatch International.

In Spring 2022, the first CyberWatch International program was a global cybersecurity exchange hosted at the CyberWatch Center's headquarters at Prince George's Community College. Two cohorts of representatives from countries in the Three Seas Region of Europe organized by World Learning in collaboration with the Fulbright Commission attended workshops in Washington, D.C. and New York.
