- **Information systems training course**
 - FIT IS – course registration, seminars, applications, . . .
 - **TONIGHT AT 8PM** (not for students in English)
 - BUT IS – BUT IS sections, language tests, courses, . . .
 - **How to create schedule and register for labs**

- IS FIT
 - always use as a primary IS, use BUT IS only when you don't find what you're looking for.
 - Registration of courses, labs, projects, ...
 - Study results, questionnaires, requests, ...
- IS BUT
 - photos, ID cards, etc.,
 - Language placement test,
 - scholarship account and scholarships,
 - BUT PIN,
 - e-learning (course IVG),
 - Free elective courses and courses from other BUT faculties (for example FFA),
 - Halls of residence, dining services, sports (CESA), ...

- Password to the FIT IS can be obtained using BUT IT password on the home page

- Remember your password! It's a problem if you forget it.
- Windows password does not change automatically (click is needed – more later).

- Home page
 - News
 - Index page
- Study
 - List of studies (can be switched)
 - Current study overview
 - List of courses and information about the fulfillment of graduation conditions
 - Information about fulfillment of graduation conditions is just approximate (assumes regular study progress)!
 - Electronic enrollment for next year
 - don't forget during the summer holiday
 - Registered theses
 - You choose topic in November of 3rd semester

- Study
 - Decisions, procedures and applications
 - Equivalent of a paper application at study department
 - Faster than a paper application
 - Contains guidelines and examples for each type of application, you won't find these at study department
 - **E.g. application to change English level**
 - Notification of withdrawal from studies
 - Form suitable for printing that hopefully none of you will need
 - Cannot be solved electronically (necessary to sign in person)

- Enrollment
 - Registration
 - Choose courses and save changes
 - Check the rules listed in notice (changes won't be saved if the rules are violated)
 - If any issues occur, please contact iveigend@fit.vut.cz or dytrych@fit.vutbr.cz (include a screenshot if you can)
 - Free elective courses are also counted into the credit ceilings, even though the form does not reflect this (it is only reflected during changes)
 - Registering bachelor's thesis topic (2nd – 3rd year)
 - Project practice registration (assuming you fulfill the conditions of summer semester of 1st year)

- Assignments (currently enrolled courses)
 - Choosing of timetable of exercises is here
 - List of assignments and tasks is displayed upon clicking the course name
 - Registration is displayed upon clicking the description of task or course seminar
 - **Automation of this process is forbidden!**
 - **Don't be late! If a capacity is full, it usually isn't increased.**
 - Use the same procedure to submit project files
 - **Submitting project solutions late is not possible in 99% of cases!**

- Team assignments
 - ① The leader will establish a team.
 - ② Leaders can register their colleagues and / or they can register themselves (leaders can also exclude non-invited members).
 - ③ The leader will register the whole team to the assignment.

- For the team assignments the lecturer can set up:
 - different times for team leader to create a team and for the team members to register (commonly it's 10 minutes),
 - after which time the leader can not exclude non-invited members – in order to guarantee the padding of teams,
 - team names generation – for unity and order,
 - whether the leader can hand over the leadership – to allow him to leave the team,
 - the minimal number of team members to allow registration to the assignment - to deny individuals to block places for teams,
 - If a team is registered for an assignment, the team leader can not unregister members under this limit (but students can leave the team).
 - maximum number of team members,
 - maximum number of teams - the number of places for teams in terms (in exercises) can be also limited and it is possible that there will be no places for some small teams,
 - after which time the team can unregister the assignment - to ensure team members are guaranteed to stay on schedule,
 - whether it will be visible which team is registered for which term.

- Team assignments tonight - exercises in IDM, ILG, IUS, IEL and IZP (for Bachelor)
 - Teams can be created starting at **7 PM**
 - only team leader can register team members in the first 10 minutes
 - maximally 60 min. for the leader to exclude non-invited students from the teams,
 - at least 3 students for registration to the term of exercises,
 - maximally 90 min. to unregister the assignment/term,
 - you can change the exercise by leaving the team and registering in to another one which has the required term of exercises.
 - **Try to create the same teams in all courses!**
 - **It is strongly recommended to start with the establishment with teams for IDM** and then only create teams with the same composition in other courses.

- Courses
 - Assignments and important dates (in enrolled courses) – staying updated is advised
 - Schedules
 - Forums
 - Course documents repository
 - Statistic results of students' course evaluation
 - please do give us feedback!

- Personal information, addresses, id cards
 - Check validity periodically (You need to confirm the information once a year using a checkbox)
 - If something is not right, submit application "notification - Update of personal information in FIT IS – Study – Administrative Procedures
- Accounts
 - Change FIT password
 - For added security, you must choose your password from the list of generated passwords
 - The change is applied to all servers within an hour
 - Microsoft Active Directory password
 - Sets FIT IS password as your Windows login password
 - BUT login password
 - Used to access BUT IS
 - FIT Radius server account
 - Used for wired and WiFi connection to network

- Other
 - Event registration
 - Available computers in computer center
 - Forms for printing
 - Most of them were replaced with applications in FIT IS

- BUT messages
 - The worst thing you can send a FIT teacher – receives an email, but has to reply in intraportal that they usually do not access
 - Do not use unless explicitly requested
- BUT mail – preferred address and application
 - Redirecting everything to one place is advised (from center to FIT). You can redirect from FIT to email client, but configuration is more advanced and support is basically unavailable.
- BUT drive, Cloud apps – for those interested
- Cards
 - Keep your photo updated
 - If you don't have a good reason, please let us see the photo
 - Don't forget to order revalidation ISIC sticker, otherwise it becomes a regular BUT student card
- BUT software – not everything is available
- Accommodation IS (including food) – link to IsKAM
- BUTpin – WiFi access (is displayed immediately – do not share with others!)
- My contacts – keep it updated

- Introductory information and personal information – are they updated?
- Studies – Overview and choice of studies
- Schedules
 - Don't look for FIT schedules – usually aren't visible and if they are, then are incomplete
 - Used for other faculties, but don't expect to find everything
- Individual schedule
 - Unusable for FIT students
 - You will see something similar as of 2nd year in FIT IS
- Electronical record book
 - Terms registration, evaluation details and other information for courses from different faculties (e.g. IDM) – only the final results are exported to FIT IS
 - Course name and abbreviation can differ in FIT IS from that in Studis (FIT course can be taught within a different course from different faculty)
 - Don't look for information regarding FIT courses here

- Free courses
 - Courses from different faculties that are not in study plan
 - These courses count as elective (including consequences upon failure)
 - Make sure there are no collisions in your schedule
- Classes registration
 - Use this only in exceptional cases of courses from different faculties
 - Most students don't have any entries here
- Course news, registration of terms and registration of specifications
 - Only for courses from different faculties

- English language placement test for Bachelor's degree programme
 - **Very important – please do take it seriously!**
 - Determines, which courses of compulsory-elective English group you have to complete.
 - Test can be generated 3x, **but submitted only once** – if you have to go to bathroom, do not submit the test.
 - The result of this test is binding – you need to file an official application to change English level.
- Scholarship and charges
 - Scholarship and Euro accounts
 - You need to set them up, otherwise you cannot receive any scholarship
 - Changes need to be confirmed in person at study department
 - Scholarship applications
 - Fees

If you encounter an issue with IS:

- Attempt to reload the page at least twice, restart browser and try again (browser cache, network is down etc.).
- Read the instructions, FAQ etc.
- In case of an obvious system error (e.g. „PHP Error“):
 - for FIT IS contact `lampa@fit.vut.cz`
 - for BUT IS contact `gadorek@fit.vut.cz` (communication with CVIS)
- If you can't say that it's a system error for sure, consult a study advisor who can report your issue.

Report needs to contain the following information:

- Date and time of occurrence
- Where did you access system from (FIT, another faculty, dormitory, home or abroad) and what type of connection did you use (cable in lab, WiFi, phone, ADSL, ...) – access can be limited
- Operating system and web browser used
- Screenshot
- A step by step instructions to recreate the issue

- WiFi
 - VUTBRNO
 - available in most BUT buildings
 - BUTlogin and BUTpin from intraportal
 - not secured (use HTTPS only)
 - eduroam
 - FIT authentication (login format xlogin00@fit.vutbr.cz and Radius server)
 - BUT authentication (login format vutlogin@vutbr.cz and BUTpin)
- Wired network
 - Authentication using Radius server
- Instructions provided by CVT, you can also contact Ing. Bohumil Michal or Ing. Tomáš Kašpárek

- **Don't forget to stop Torrents etc.**
 - what you are downloading is always shared to others by you
 - your FIT account (including all services) can be locked fast and can prevent you even from registering seminar groups and other activities
 - unlocking an account is lengthy and unpleasant (CVT training course – Ing. Michal)
 - violation is filed for possible prosecution
 - repeated violation of the code will result in a disciplinary proceedings

- There is a choice is Windows or Linux OS – it is selected when starting a PC.
- An advanced user may log in on multiple PCs at the same time (if he or she does not block others and does not allow someone else to work under his / her account), but in most cases you will break the own roaming profile and then you will not be able to log in at all.
- It is strictly forbidden to disconnect the keyboards, monitors, or other cables from the PC (there are a lot of students and the connectors would soon give up the service). Your own PCs can be connected only in rooms M103 and M104.

- On some CVT servers (eg. eva or merlin) you can work remotely, but:
 - before logging off, make sure that you do not have running processes on the server to make resources available for other students,
 - with the exception of working under expert supervision, do not download a large amount of data from the web – when some server will be overloaded, your account will be blocked immediately,
 - no faculty machine may be used for the commercial purposes (they are for study, science and approved research only).

How to create your time table

- 1 Select elective courses.
- 2 Find 4 friends to form a team with (ideally with the same set of courses).
- 3 Select a lecture group.
- 4 Create your ideal time table.
- 5 Prepare for the possibility that it might not work out – choose alternatives.
- 6 Choose an appropriate (and quick) leader and create teams in the IS.
- 7 Try to enroll.
- 8 Find appropriate solutions to problems.

- Elective courses might have schedule collisions with some activities in mandatory courses (lectures for one lecture group, some exercises or labs, ...).
- Elective courses might have just one lecture or exercise time.
- It might not be possible to create a time table with all elective courses in one lecture group.
- The team is registered by a leader – he/she should know, what to evade!

- 1 Choose a group based on the first letter of your surname:
 - BIA with surnames beginning with A – M,
 - BIB with surnames beginning with N – Ž.
- 2 Check if some lecture does not have a schedule collision with your elective courses. If it doesn't, you've just picked your lecture group.
- 3 If there is a collision, check the number of collisions for the second lecture group. If the number of collisions is smaller, choose the second one.

- Start filling your time table by:
 - 1 Elective courses with just one available time slot.
 - 2 Elective courses with more than one available time slot.
 - 3 Lectures from the lecture group that do not have collisions.
 - 4 Pick the lectures that had collisions from the second lecture group.
 - 5 Exercises and labs

- You can have more variants (2 or 3) of the entire time table – probably not possible.
- You can have alternatives for every course („if we don't get IDM on Monday at 6 PM, we can try Thursday at 6 PM or Friday at 7 AM“).
 - Attractive slots are full within 10 seconds!
 - The alternative without collisions is necessary.

- The team leader should have good internet connection, large enough screen and quick hands ...
 - but mostly the trust of others – the leader is going to make the decision.
 - **Do not be angry with the leader, if the resulting schedule is not perfect – the competition is huge.**
- Teams have to be created before registrations 7 PM – 7:45 PM.
- You have to click exactly at the specified time, if you don't succeed, quickly click on the alternative ...

- **You don't have a team and registrations are already in progress?**
- You can join any other team, that has room.
- After registrations for tasks begins, you can pick a team that has a time slot you want.
- **BUT** if you join a team that you do not know, you can be kicked out or the team can change the selected time slot (**you cannot be removed after 90 minutes**).

- What if we did not find any time slot without collisions?
- Teachers cannot influence registrations – it would be hellish (if one request is approved, then every has to be and there is 750 students in the first year)!
- **You have to manage yourselves.**
 - Try to create a usable time table only using free time slots.
 - You can split your team and find a spot in the incomplete teams with better time slots.
 - Watch for changes.
- Time slot exchanges
 - **Myth** „Teacher, study advisor, referent, . . . can exchange us.“
 - Hard work – no one wants to solve tens of exchanges.
 - 2 students in the early morning or night time can exchange within 3 seconds, teacher has to deregister the student from the first slot, find the student in the second slot, register. That might take a minute when almost everyone is online and can take the slot!
 - With 750 students, the probability of failure is high.
