FOREIGN LANGUAGES TUITION FOR STUDENTS OF FIT AT BRNO UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY AT FEEC AT BRNO UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY

BACHELOR DEGREE PROGRAMME OF STUDY

Students in the bachelor study programme will begin studying English language in <u>the</u> <u>summer semester of the first year</u>, or in the winter semester of the second year. Students can study the English language for up to four semesters, depending on their current knowledge. All students are required to pass the intermediate level examination (level B1+) or higher by the end of their bachelor's programme. If they achieve an excellent result in the English placement test, they can register for the English examination in the winter semester of the first year (**ZAN4**).

Recognition of the examination in English language

Students who have passed a general state or an international examination in English language – *State Examination in English Language* and international examinations: *First Certificate in English (FCE), Certificate in Advanced English (CAE), Certificate of Proficiency in English (CPE)*, or a course from their previous studies (e.g. B(X)AN4), <u>do not attend the English language tuition</u>. They will have it recognized <u>during the first year at the study advisor at the Department of Languages at FEEC for FIT – dr.</u> <u>Baumgartnerová</u>. Under specific circumstances, *International English Language Testing System (IELTS), Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL)* exams can also be recognised, but each such case is a subject to individual evaluation. These students <u>do not go through</u> the placement language test (see below). They also do not register for English-focused language courses. Certificates listed above can be recognized for up to five years from the time of holding the respective examination. <u>No other exams can be recognized</u>. Should there be any requests for an exception to recognizing different certificates, please consult the study advisor at the Department of Languages at FEEC for FIT - dr. Baumgartnerová.

<u>Course recognition request filed via the BUT information system in Studis</u> \rightarrow <u>Administrative procedures and applications</u> (Recognition of courses - Request for recognition of the course BAN4) requires a course exam certificate. The study advisor from the Department of Languages may subsequently ask the student to present the original certificate in person.

Recognition of the BAN4 exam is governed by the current FIT regulation (<u>http://www.fit.vutbr.cz/study/advisor/aktualni_vyhlasky/uznavani.pdf</u>).

Determining the English language knowledge level

Before registering for a language course, first-year students of the bachelor's programme are required (until 30th November of the respective year) to take the English placement test located at <u>www.vutbr.cz/jazyk</u>. This test serves to determine the language knowledge level and assign students to a course corresponding to their knowledge level. It must be filled in responsibly!

It is advised that students register for the **AIT** course, instead of the compulsory BAN4 course if thev obtain score of 51 60 points. а _ To register for the **BAN4** course, students need to obtain a score of 41-50 points, to register for the **BAN3** course, students need to obtain a score of 31-40 points, to register for the BAN2 course, students need to obtain a score of 21-30 points, to register for the BAN1 course, students need to obtain a score of 11-20 points. If a student reaches one of the two highest levels, there is a choice of other language courses for the same level. Follow the current Decision of the Dean of the FIT BUT for registration for courses (https://www.fit.vut.cz/fit/info/smernice/sm2022-02-en_full.pdf) and the guidelines listed in the news section of FIT BUT the webpages (https://www.fit.vut.cz/study/study-news/.en) during the registration of the particular course and requesting a knowledge level change.

Students that obtain a score of <u>10 or less points</u> must complement their knowledge of the English language independently, they are not offered any language course in this case. Consequently, following the <u>Decision of the Dean of the FIT BUT for registration</u> for courses (see above) and the guidelines listed in the news section of FIT web pages, they can request to be assigned to the BAN1 or BAN2 course.

Higher English level courses and other foreign languages

Students, who do not need to attend 4-semester tuition in English language to be able to pass the compulsory BAN4 examination and have passed this examination (alternatively AIT examination) and wish to continue studying the language, are offered the possibility to register for specialized English language courses (AIT, <u>if not completed</u> <u>yet</u>, BPC-PA1, BPC-PA2, BPC-PA3, BPC-PA4, BPC-BEN, AEU and JA3), which last one semester each.

Second-year students can also register for a two-semester course of another foreign language.

The list of courses offered to students of the bachelor's programme and detailed information about each of these courses can be found in the BUT information system.

Course enrolment and tuition

Students register for language courses via the Information system of the Brno University of Technology. The tuition itself takes place at FEEC of the Brno University of Technology, 10 Technická street.

INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS APPLYING FOR STUDENT ACCOMMODATION WITHIN THE ERASMUS PROGRAMME

An authorized employee of the Department of Languages at FEEC of Brno University of Technology will prove the knowledge level of students during the selection procedure for student accommodation at a term set by the management at FIT – students are obliged to follow the news of their home faculty. Students in need of re-examination and verification of their language competence can consult the representative for international relations – <u>Ing. Studená</u>, and after her approval the examiner – <u>PhDr.</u><u>Borecká</u>.

MASTER DEGREE PROGRAMME OF STUDY

A list of available language courses for students of the master degree programme at FIT of Brno University of Technology can be found on the Department of Languages at FEEC webpages and detailed information for each of the courses can be found in the BUT information system.

Each language course requires a semester test and a final examination to be completed.

Students of the master's programme follow the <u>Decision of the Dean of the FIT BUT for</u> registration for courses (<u>https://www.fit.vut.cz/fit/info/smernice/sm2022-02-</u> <u>en_full.pdf</u>) and the guidelines listed in the news section of FIT web pages (<u>https://www.fit.vut.cz/study/study-news/.en</u>). Students can register for language courses via the information system of Brno University of Technology. The tuition itself takes place at the Department of Languages at FEEC of Brno University of Technology, 10 Technická street.

DOCTORAL PROGRAMME OF STUDY

The Department of Languages at FEEC also offers **a specialized English language course for the doctoral programme students** - JA6D. The prerequisite for enrolment in this course is English language knowledge at an intermediate level, i.e. ZAN4, BAN4, AIT examination, or a completed specialized course at intermediate or higher level.

Compulsory English examination

Students in the doctoral programme are required to pass an examination in the English language for Ph.D. Students can take this examination after they have completed the JA6D course, or they can register for the JAD examination only.
